## 2022 FOOTBALL POOL

1. Point spreads will be used for all games as they appear in the Wednesday edition of the Toronto Sun newspaper. Should the Toronto Sun, for any reason not publish the point spreads, then the Toronto Star will be used. The point spreads from the answering machine will be the official point spread.

## THERE IS A WEB SITE WWW.NFLFOOTBALLPOOL.CA THAT WILL HAVE THE WEEKLY SCHEDULE WITH POINT SPREADS AND RESULTS FROM THE PREVIOUS WEEK. ALSO THE STANDINGS WILL BE AVAILABLE ON THIS WEB SITE. YOU CAN PRINT A COPY RIGHT FROM THE WEB PAGE.

2. Every precaution will be taken to ensure that the point spreads are transferred correctly to the answering machine. In the event that there is a discrepancy please use the ones recorded on the tape. The sheets will be scored using those spreads.
3. Ten points per game will be allotted.

Example: San Diego $\qquad$ at Dallas $\qquad$
Spread is San Diego by 3
If you feel that San Diego will win by more than 3 points, then you would put a "10" beside San Diego and a "0" beside Dallas. You do the opposite if you think Dallas will not lose by more than 3 points.

However, if you are not sure and want to get some points out of the game, you can do the following:

## Example: San Diego favored by 3:

You have: San Diego 6 at Dallas 4
If the final score is San Diego 20 and Dallas 13, you would receive 6 points for that game.
If the final score is San Diego 20 and Dallas 18, you would receive 4 points for that game.
If the final score is San Diego 20 and Dallas 17, only those people with a TIE beside both teams would get " 25 " points, everyone else would get zero for that game ( because the point spread is 3 and the game is considered a tie.)
4. If you feel San Diego will win by exactly 3 points, than put a "TIE" beside both teams. If San Diego wins exactly by 3 points then you would receive 25 points for that game. However, you may select only 2(two) ties in any given week, For those who select more than two ties only the first two heard on the tape will be considered and you will receive zero for the others. Also, if you call in and pick all your games as ties, the above rule will apply, but you will not be eligible for last place prize in the pool.

NOTE: San Diego 5 at Dallas 5 (does not constitute a tie!!!)
5. After you have done the above for all the games that week, call the phone number you will be given and follow the instructions precisely.
6. You will also receive a personal identification number to use when calling.
7. The answering machine will be left on until game time. For weeks with Thursday, Friday or Saturday games, you can make your selections for those games, and then call back for the sunday games before 1 pm Sunday...
8. Any person not calling on time or not calling at all will receive the low score for that week.
9. Make sure that you call in every week because this year there will be a prize for the person finishing last, but he must call in his or her picks every week. (If you forget to call in your scores one week, you are not eligible.)
10. There will be a 50 point bonus given to anyone picking all games correctly.
11. There will be a 100 point bonus given to anyone picking all games incorrectly.
12. There will be only one winner per week this year. When calling in your picks you must also give a total score for the MONDAY NIGHT game. The winner for the week will be the person with the highest score, but if there is a tie in the score between two or more people, then the closest to the total score of the Monday night game will be the winner of the weekly prize.It does not matter if your total score is over or under the total score of the game.
(For example: ID\#2 \& ID\#3 are tied with 110 points for the week going into Monday night. Both people have the same team on Monday night, their team wins which gives them 120 points each. The total score of the game was 43. ID\#2 called the total score to be 40. ID\#3 called the total score to be 49. In this case ID\#2 would win the week as his total was closer to 43.
